

SIS STATISTICS 2024 - FACTSHEET

The Schengen Information System (SIS) remains the most widely used large-scale IT system for internal security in the Schengen area. Following the system's recast, operational since March 2023, its new enlarged functionalities ensure a higher level of security. The system plays a key role in supporting cooperation between law enforcement and judicial authorities across Europe, crucial to safeguarding the free movement of people and providing a more effective management of external borders.

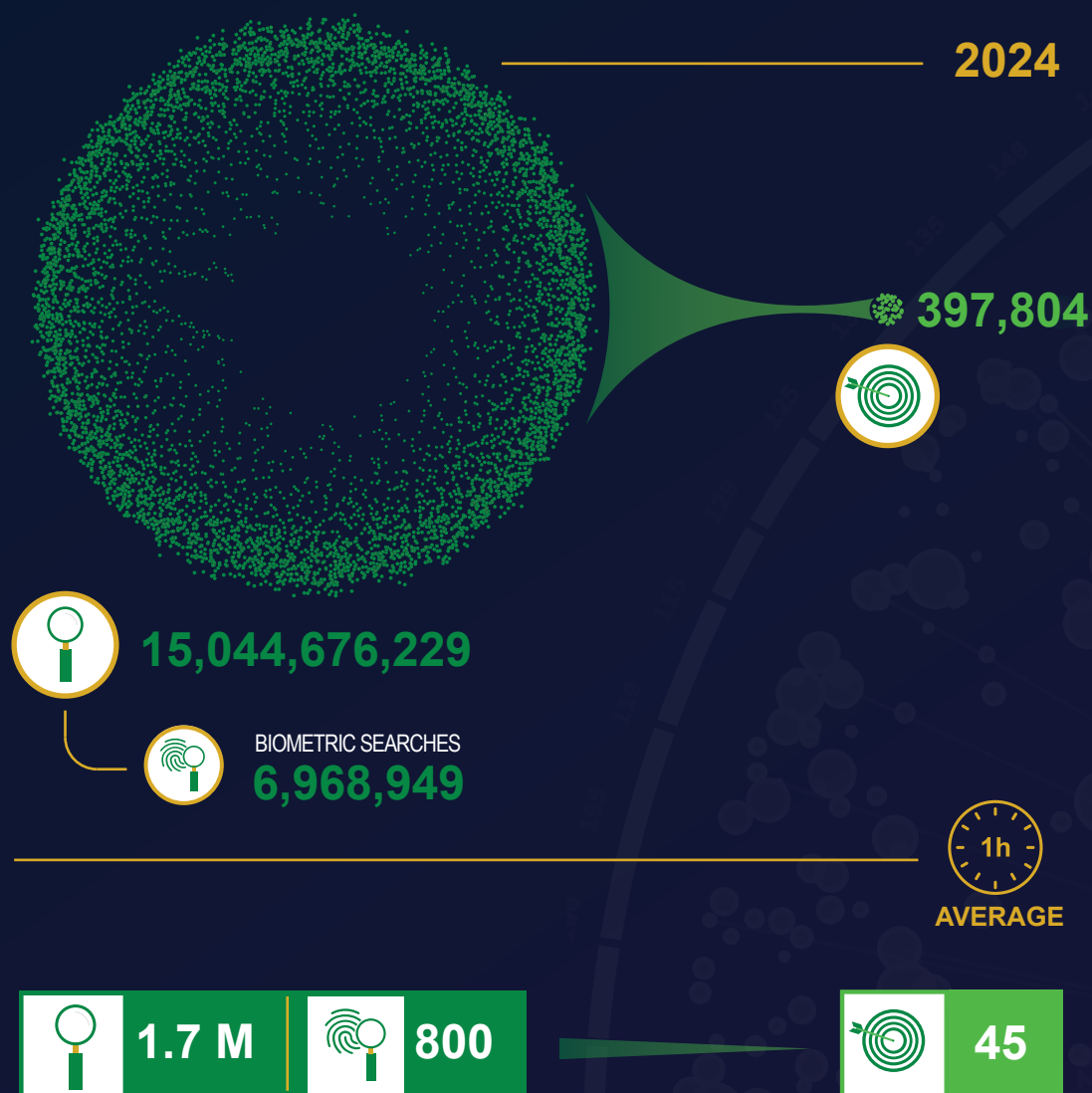
